## Blueberry Special Fertilizer

12-12-12 fertilizer with minor elements.

**First-Year Plants:** Wait until the first leaves have reached full size before fertilizing. Apply 1 Tbs. of Blueberry Special within a circle 1' from the plant. Repeat application of fertilizer at 6-week intervals, depending upon rainfall or irrigation, until midsummer.

**Second-Year Plants:** Apply 2 Tbs. (1 oz.) and increase the circle up to 1½' from the plant. First application should be made when new growth begins in spring.

**Bearing Plants:** Apply one cup of Blueberry Special when new growth begins in the spring.

**Caution:** Blueberries are easily damaged by excess fertilizer. Allow for rain or irrigation between fertilizer applications.

**Remember:** Always check your soil pH. Blueberries desire a pH from 4.2 - 5.0. Blueberry plant roots are near the top of the ground. Mulching blueberries improves bush growth and survival.
